

Crisis Intervention and Crisis Stabilization Faxes

Effective December 1, 2021, providers will no longer be able to submit registration requests for Crisis Stabilization (H2019) and Crisis Intervention (H0036) on www.magellanprovider.com as these services are terminating as part of the Project Bravo (Behavioral Health Redesign for Access, Value and Outcomes). Magellan recognizes that these services have submission timeframes of one to two business days. Starting December 1, 2021, providers will need to fax requests for these services that were initiated prior to December 1, 2021. Permission will not be required to fax for these services beginning December 1, 2021, as these services will no longer exist and are transitioning to Mobile Crisis Response (H2011) and Community Stabilization (S9482) and Residential Crisis Stabilization Unit (H2018), as appropriate.
