

Telehealth Webex Event

This communication is being sent on behalf of the Virginia Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS)

The Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) is excited to invite stakeholders to a webinar to review proposed changes to Virginia Medicaid's long-term telehealth policy. Prior to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, DMAS last issued a comprehensive update to telehealth policy in 2014, with a clarification of coverage for Federally Qualified Health Centers issued in 2019. DMAS is currently posting for public comment a “Telehealth Services Supplement” provider manual (<https://www.dmas.virginia.gov/media/3428/telehealth-services-supplement-updated-05-19-2021.pdf>).

This Supplement defines key telehealth terms, lists the set of services reimbursable when delivered via telemedicine - as well as associated billing requirements and telehealth service limitations - and describes requirements for providers, documentation, member choice and education, and telehealth equipment and technology. The draft Telehealth Services Supplement focuses on services delivered via telemedicine; policies and requirements for additional telehealth modalities – including additional store-and-forward services, provider-to-provider consultations, virtual communications, Remote Patient Monitoring, and audio-only services – will be communicated in future Provider Manual updates. The purpose of the webinar will be to review proposed changes to long-term telehealth policy and address participants' questions.

DMAS will be offering the webinar twice:

- Tuesday, June 8, 12 - 1:30 pm.
- Wednesday, June 9, 12 - 1:30 pm.

While the content presented during both webinars will be identical, DMAS Subject Matter Experts in Behavioral Health will be available to address participants' questions in the webinar held on Tuesday, June 8.
