



# Are you or someone you know receiving Intensive In-Home Services (IIH) or Intensive Community Treatment? (ICT)

If so, there are some things you need to know.

You may now receive Case Management Services from your local  
**Community Services Board**

Before January 30, 2015, Case Management was a part of Intensive In-Home Services for youth and Intensive Community Treatment for adults. Case Management was not offered as a separate service. These two services will now include Case Coordination, also called Service Coordination.

From January 30, 2015 and after, Case Management is no longer part of Intensive In-Home Services or Intensive Community Treatment. Case Management is now available as a separate service for youth receiving Intensive In-Home Services and Adults receiving Intensive Community Treatment.

Case Management is a service that can help you and/or family members:

- get linked to needed resources
- find a family doctor or psychiatrist
- connect to education or job training
- become more involved in your community
