Guidance for youth admitted in Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility or Therapeutic Group Home prior to July 1, 2017 - Reassessment Process

Any youth placed in a Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility (PRTF) or Therapeutic Group Home (TGH) prior to July 1, 2017 will begin the IACCT reassessment process starting October 2017.

If the youth has a continued stay request due between July 1 2017 and September 30, 2017 Magellan will require the following from the PRTF or TGH provider:

Youth connected with CSA:

- Service Authorization Request form (Continued Stay), CIPOC, Rate Sheet, CANS

Youth not connected with CSA:

- Service Authorization Request form (Continued Stay), CIPOC

NOTE: Youth with an authorization through the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) EPSDT department will also need to go through the reassessment process starting October 2017.

For IACCT Providers:

The Magellan Residential Care Manager will send a notification 30 days before the October 2017 Reassessment due date. The notification will include the name of the residential facility and the clinical contact information. The IACCT LMHP will begin care coordination with the residential facility to complete the reassessment process.

The Reassessment process includes:

- A psychosocial addendum if deemed clinically necessary by the IACCT LMHP
- A CANS

If the youth has a current Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Assessment the IACCT LMHP will complete the additional Magellan CANS 2016 modules and enter this into the Magellan “Manage Outcomes” system.

If the youth does not have a current Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Assessment the IACCT LMHP will complete a Magellan CANS 2016 Comprehensive Form in the Magellan “Manage Outcomes” system.

Certificate of Need (CON) completed prior to July 1, 2017

If a CON was completed prior to July 1, 2017 the CON is considered active for 30 days. The youth can be placed in a PRTF or TGH using the active CON. Youth who are placed in a PRTF or TGH using the active CON do not need to go through the IACCT process.
