



## Serious Mental Illness (SMI) Screening

GAP SMI eligibility is one part of the GAP eligibility application process. GAP SMI screening entities submit the mental health diagnostic evaluation and the screening portion for clinical review by Magellan. There are two types of screenings.

<b>Limited Screening:</b>	<b>Full Screening:</b>
Conducted for individuals who have had a mental health diagnostic evaluation within the past 12 months and the evaluation is available to the screener.	Conducted for individuals who have not had a diagnostic evaluation within the past 12 months or for whom the evaluation is not available to the screener.
This screening may be completed by a Qualified Mental Health Professional-Adult (QMHP-A or QMHP-Eligible) or a Licensed Mental Health Professional (LMHP), including supervisees and residents.	A diagnostic evaluation is completed at the time of the screening by an LMHP (including supervisees and residents).
The screening date and the LMHP diagnostic evaluation date do not have to be same, but the diagnostic evaluation must have been completed within the last 12 months.	The screening date and LMHP diagnostic evaluation date must be the same; they should be completed on the same.

### For both screenings:

- Each evaluation must have the date of completion and the signature/name and credentials of the LMHP
- Both the LMHP diagnostic evaluation and the GAP SMI screening must be uploaded when submitting to the Magellan provider portal
