Subject: Integrated Healthcare and Care Coordination Training and Resources

Integrated behavioral health care has been defined as "the care that results from a practice team of primary care and behavioral health clinicians, working together with patients and families, using a systematic and cost-effective approach to provide patient-centered care for a defined population."ⁱ One in four Americans struggle with a mental health or substance use problem. Over 12 million visits to emergency departments on an annual basis are due to individuals with mental health and substance use disorders; many people are unable to make an appointment to see a primary care physician. According to the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) Academy, sixty percent of those suffering from a mental disorder get no care. For those who do get care, only twenty percent are able to see a mental health professional and most receive treatment from their primary care physicians. Only twenty-five percent of these individuals, who receive care, actually get better. Two thirds of Primary Care Physicians report poor access to mental health services for their patients. More than half of the counties in the United States do not have a single practicing mental health professional.
