Introduction

This presentation is a guide to billing the referring provider information on all psychiatric residential treatment facility (PRTF) claims submitted to Magellan of Virginia as well as a reminder about ARTS ASAM 3.3 – 3.7 claims. The following topics will be covered:

Ordering, Referring and Prescribing Provider (ORP) Requirements

The Code of Federal Regulations 455.410(b) states that State Medicaid agencies must require all ordering or referring physicians or other professionals providing services under the State plan or under a waiver of the plan to be enrolled as participating providers.

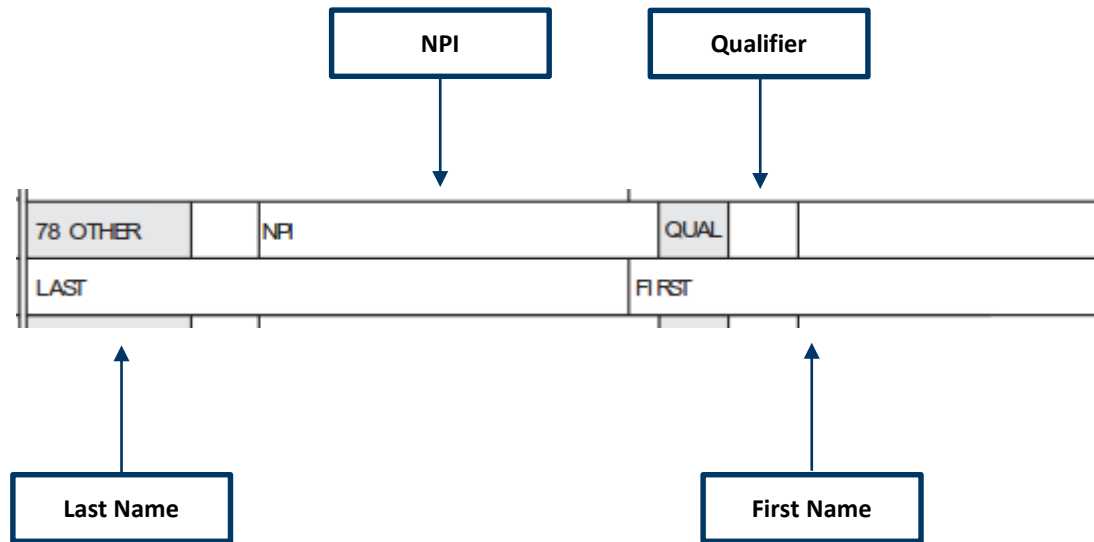
- Designed to ensure all orders, prescriptions or referrals for items or services for Medicaid beneficiaries originate from appropriately licensed practitioners who have not been excluded from Medicare or Medicaid.
- The ORP provider must be enrolled with Medicaid to ensure claims will be paid to the servicing provider who is billing for the service.

Changes to Billing Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility Claims

Effective October 1, 2017, psychiatric residential treatment facility claims billed with revenue code 1001 or 0961 with dates of service October 1, 2017 and later, will require the referring National Provider Identifier (NPI) on the claim.

- Magellan will accept the physician from the Independent Assessment, Certification and Coordination Team or the billing facility's attending physician as the referring provider on the claim, as long as their NPI is enrolled as a Medicaid provider.
- If billing on the UB04 paper claim form, submit the NPI, first name and last name of the referring provider as well as the qualifier "DN" in box 78.
- If billing electronically, in the 837I referring provider loop 2310F, submit the NPI, first name and last name of the referring provider as well as the qualifier "DN".
- The referring NPI cannot be the same as the rendering NPI. This applies to both facility and professional claims for PRTF services.

Billing Requirements for Addiction and Recovery Treatment Services (ARTS) ASAM 3.3 – 3.7 Claims

The referring provider requirement applies to facility claims billed for ASAM levels 3.3, 3.5 or 3.7 as defined for the ARTS program since April 1, 2017.

- This includes revenue code 1002 billed with procedure codes H0010 TG, H0010 HB, H0010 HA, H2036 HB, and H2036 HA.
- Magellan will accept the physician as the referring provider for ARTS residential claims as long as their NPI is enrolled as a Medicaid provider.
- If there is no referring physician, the NPI of the billing facility's physician is acceptable.
- If billing on the UB04 paper claim form, submit the NPI, first name and last name of the referring provider as well as the qualifier "DN" in box 78.
- If billing electronically, in the 837I referring provider loop 2310F, submit the NPI, first name and last name of the referring provider as well as the qualifier "DN".
- The referring NPI cannot be the same as the rendering NPI. This applies to both facility and professional claims for ARTS 3.3, 3.5 and 3.7 services.

Submission Tips

The following will ensure timely adjudication of claims and prevent rejections of claims submissions:

- ✓ For all facility and professional claims, the referring NPI is not the same as the rendering NPI.
- ✓ The claim includes the NPI, name and DN qualifier in box 78 on the paper claim or in the referring provider loop 2310F for electronic claims.
- ✓ The ORP or attending is enrolled with Medicaid.
- ✓ For PRTF claims, the referring provider is the physician from the IACCT or the billing facility's attending physician.
- ✓ For ARTS residential claims, the referring provider is the physician or the billing facility's attending physician.
