Magellan of Virginia is looking for additional Independent Assessment, Certification and Coordination Team (IACCT) providers. For all Medicaid funded psychiatric residential admissions, referrals are made to Magellan, at which point the IACCT assesses medical necessity to determine the proper level of care and coordinate as appropriate. The IACCT is essential in finding the most clinically appropriate and least restrictive setting for the member as well as ensuring family engagement throughout the process. It also ensures care is provided in a manner that best suits the needs of each youth and family, including preferences related to provider location, specialties, spoken languages, gender, and cultural aspects.

We would like to expand our IACCT network with providers that have the following prior experience:

- Care coordination
- Diagnostic/psychosocial assessments
- Working with children and families
- Knowledge of Virginia's system of care

Additionally, providers must meet the minimum requirements:

- You must currently hold or be willing to obtain Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) certification (available on Magellan's provider web portal www.magellanhealth.com/provider)
- You must have at least one staff member who holds active licensure as a licensed mental health professional (LMHP)
